## Transitioning into Kindergarten

- Grant Opportunity
  - Collab with Head Start
  - Jamboree
  - See what the schools are already doing (PS 13)
    - Target schools / programs (providers/home providers) who are not doing or not capable of doing any transition activities
  - Family engagement
  - Target programs surrounding local district school and have them meet at centralized location (school) to host event
  - Grant needs to be exhausted before 8/31
    - Needs to begin end of june beginning of july
  - PS 21 principal willing to be a part of opportunity
  - PS 18 newly opened community school
  - PS 44 Mariners Harbor
  - Initial meeting (transitional conference) to speak with families of children going into programs to let them know what is planned
  - QualityStars can reach out to providers within targeted zip codes to provide support
