Early Intervention Initiative

- EI Data Analysis
 - What information needs to be collected and shared?
 - What is the best way to collect information from families
 - Host a EI forum
 - Invite EI experts to speak
 - Include panel discussion
 - Have smaller rooms available for more concentrated discussion
 - Have space available for video testimonies
 - Host smaller meetings / conversation sessions with families throughout the summer months- to gain information, testimonies, etc
 - Use information/testimonies when planning bigger forum event in the fall
 - Reach out to providers and see what problems they are facing when it comes to meeting eligible families where they are at.
 - Why are some neighborhoods (the north shore) underserved vs other neighborhoods on the island?
 - All services can be provided virtually OT, PT, speech, etc
