Kindergarten Transitioning Initiative

- Updates
 - Educators Activate
 - Held virtually on June 9
 - Over 23 educators and early learn providers attended
 - Creating an opportunity to hold two events yearly for teachers and providers to come together
 - Give some of the feedback over to the Parent WG,
 specifically the feedback on independence
 - Make sure they understand the importance of, and benefits of consistent attendance
 - Parents act like kindergarten is not mandatory
 - Social emotional needs are neglected
 - Have a Kindergarten teacher come down to the preK class and give a little lesson to prepare the incoming students
 - Invite the parents as well
- See what DOE has on the importance of kindergarten to spread to Parent WG for them to disseminate to other parents



- Use social media to spread message
- During school events make announcement regarding importance of kindergarten and other affiliated topics
 - Reach out to the schools
 - We Got Your Back Event
 - June 16 @ PS 18
 - Remind to be sent out later today (June 13)
 - Moving into Kindergarten folders to be given out
 - Each table will have one piece of the school supply list to be given out to the families
 - At the end of the event the incoming students
 will have lunch with the current K students
 - Group photo will be taken at the end of the event
 - August 3rd @ PS 21
 - Hunger Free NYC has 11 volunteers for the event who speak various languages
- Possible commercial or skit
 - Skit on coming on time to class (preK or K) show the benefits and what the child could miss if they consistently come late
- Host a We Got Your Back Event at the Mariner's Harbor Library to reach the intended number of children
 - Reach out to parent coordinator of PS 44 for the kindergarten list and spread the word to the families about the event
 - o Will take place later in august
