- Data Walk Poster Review
 - All data should be from 2022
 - Instead of comparing ZIP codes to citywide data, have them compared to staten island data
 - Use horizontal graph template
 - Parent testimonials poster
 - Title change suggestions:
 - Staten Island EI Parent Testimonials
 - Make clear that these testimonials are coming from Staten Island parents who have been through the EI process
 - Add context: how long should the process take?
 - Add to the cheat sheet
 - Include Zip codes from the parents who shared testimonials
 - Split the testimonial quotes - 2 to a page
 - Add discussion questions to the posters
 - Double check for spelling/syntax errors
 - Make a clearer key for the graphs
 - Define what each criteria means
 - Referred, evaluated, etc
 - What does general services mean?

- Have 2 charts with local data and one with citywide data
 - Scale it one to 100 (on the y-axis)
- Have 3 separate charts
 - ZIP CODE data
 - Staten Island Overall data
 - Citywide Data
- Should the charts be in one poster or 3 separate posters?
 - Depending on the display options
- Check CCC for Staten Island Overall Data
 - The only available data is from 2020
