 - o Short blurbs, bullet points, minimal data, white space
- Feedback on shared Policy Paper documents:

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- Knowing the correct jargon to use to best c E ENVIRONMENT information [we] are looking to convey so our target audience understands
 - Do not overwhelm the paper with too much data as to not overwhelm our audience
- Use the feedback given during Let's Talk Conversations to form the Policy Paper
- 1. Raising awareness in regards to parents rights around the EI process
 - Have an information session on EI for parents when they are beginning the process Money should be allocated to create an awareness campaign regarding Early Intervention
 - Create a youtube video
 - Host a panel
 - Post the marketing in the SIA EI hub on the website so parents can be referred there by doctors, family, etc
- 2. Length of the process
 - The entire process is meant to take 45 days, yet many parents waited from 2mos to 1 year from evaluation to services

o 3. Knowing parents can be re-evaluated

- Middle ground can be provided by CBOs
 - A safe place for parents can bring their children to meet with providers to perform evaluations
- Raising awareness will help show parents who are hesitant regarding EI that it is in their child's best interest
