- KT Data Collection - *What is the best way to collect the information we will be gathering from speaking w/ teachers?*
- How can we get information TO the teachers themselves?
 - Create one pager with list of resources for teachers
- (PS 18 teachers feedback) Issues teachers are dealing with:
 - Holding pencils
 - Standing on a line
 - Styling still - not running around
 - Easily distracted - constant want to play
 - TARDINESS
 - 8 children out of 2 classrooms who are consistently late
 - Missing out on very important morning (SEL) lessons\
 - Following directions
 - Not knowing how to deal w/ their emotions
- Create a survey for the teachers and use their responses to inform programs for next year's programming
 - Separate forms for preK and K?
- Full list of teachers and paras in all affiliated schools needed
- Supports requested:
 - Behavioral
 - Dealing w/ high expectations
 - Parent workshops

- What is the process to refer a child to an IEP
- Emotional supports for the teachers
 - Mental health supports
- Work with school administrators
- More data from other schools are needed – Can share best practices between schools depending on findings

EI Equity Project

- Let's Talk EI @ NY Foundling Healthy Families
 - 19 Families joined
 - Friendly Face - provide ABA services
 - Lack of evaluators and providers causing massive delays in the process
 - Many psychologists leave very quickly and eventually turn to private practice
- Compiling data for BEI/Legislators
 - Reach out to CCC for a format from BEI to use when sharing data
 - Write out common issues and check off during subsequent conversations when another family shares the same feedback (track trends much easier)
- Aligning Qualitative and Quantitative Data
 - How does the CCC data speak to the qualitative data we have gathered from parents?
 - Speak to service providers to share their stories
