- 8th Annual Early Childhood Enrollment Event
 - 470 families attended the event (1,000 families registered)
 - 84 families joined the alliance mailing list
 - UNECE
 - 88 families in enrollment - 54 inquired about services
 - 17 - 3k/pre k enrollment through myschools
 - 1 family assisted in EI
 - 23 organizations joined
- Partner Feedback:
 - How does the data compare to last year?
 - Attendance has doubled
 - Look into why the numbers are growing
 - Send out a survey (in partnership with the museum) - Attached to the registration
 - how did [you] hear about the event?
 - How likely are families to come to future SIA events? What topics are they interested in learning more about?
