Kindergarten Transitioning Activities

- How do we measure impact?
 - Is there more parent engagement over the course of the school year as a result of the activities? Have there been less behavioral issues? DATA
 - Child Readiness – Common Agenda
 - Reach out to the ELE WG to get their feedback on what data points are important to collect
 - PARTICIPATION NUMBERS
 - What schools participated? Returning-New?
 - Families?
 - For those schools that are returning – what worked well? What was the impact for your families
 - Try and use data to help bridge the gaps between the parents and the teachers
 - Take the data points to the ELE WG – they can take the data and make it into something workable
 - Bring data to Pre-K so they can tackle some of the issues before they become issues in the school setting
 - Collect data around rise in nonverbal children – kids who don't speak or communicate with their teachers, etc.
 - Track new data points that had been brought up by the teachers during the educators activate workshops – collective parent data as well and share with each other
 - Take what the norm should be and compare it to what the teachers are reporting
 - Do families KNOW what the norms are? What do they THINK the norms are? Are they aligned? What do teachers WANT parents to know?
 - Use list of developmental milestones as a rubric – one specific to kindergarten (reach out to the ELE WG)

- Ask teachers who participated in Educator's Activate to write up a list of 5 things they would want parents to know
- What are the parent's expectations on what being ready for kindergarten means
- Compare to teacher's feedback
- Have mid-year and end of year check-ins with educators
- Note with Dona:
 - Focus in on one family – did anything change within the year.

Early Childhood Enrollment

- North Shore DOE Data Review
 - Look at cumulative data rather than individual data
 - Will send public school attendance data to PDI data person for filtering

Steering Committee Feedback

- In agreement with overall feedback
- Feedback is in line with the general understanding of the WG as a whole
- Work on recruiting new members – those who gave feedback on the WG goals/action items during the SC meeting
- Better communication between the KS WG and Policy & Advocacy WG
- Better feedback loop between ALL the WGs
 - What information/data do the WGs need and working to get that information to them
- Take into consideration ALL data points
 - Weather, how long running a particular event is, how many people registered/attended (8th Annual event)
- Pull data from previous events (8th annual event)
