 - Partner Discussion

 - <u>3/4k what is being taught in these settings?</u>
 - Are they going over basic things?
 - Not all of the 'pressure' should be on the parents
 - Do families have the supplies needed to do certain activities?
 - Pencils, crayons, construction paper etc. (kinetic and fine motor activities)
 - Pervasion of technology has been damaging to kinetic and fine motor skills (writing their name, etc.)
 - Reach out to other partners who support pregnant women and have them work to educate future parents
 - OB/GYN centers have resources available to soon to be parents so they are prepared, well informed and engaged before they even have their child
 - Health courses, parent course in high school
 - KNOWLEDGE IS KEY (mindfulness)
 - Where do [the parents] start?
 - Can be overwhelming parents comparing themselves to each other or what is deemed correct
 - Understand that parents are struggling and work to understand why they are struggling – try and ease whatever struggles we can to help them be more involved in teaching their children
 - Print concepts
 - Create toolkit for parents with teachers' guidance (PS 18 & PS 74)
 - How do we disseminate this resource to parents?

Data Review

- Chronic Absenteeism Data
 - Post pandemic attitude towards attendance
 - Many children either won't show up or will come at whatever time their parents bring them in
 - Will cause behavior challenges when a child is brought in late – throws off their routine and makes it difficult for them to follow along with the class
 - Transportation issues
 - Parent work schedule
 - Parents wondering if it is necessary for their child to be in school for so many hours 5 days a week at such a young age
 - Parents accepting seats in schools and not sending their children in preventing other parents/families from sending their child/ren.
 - What can be done to shift the mindset of families?
 - What can we speak to educators about implementing into their lessons to make sure that their students are prepared for kindergarten?
 - Social emotion learning!
 - Interview parents of chronically absent kids and try and figure out the reasons they don't send their child to school
 - Child didn't want to go, didn't want to wake up, pre-k/kinder is optional, etc.
