### **Updates**

- We Got Your Back Events
  - o UFT BBQ @ PS 21
    - 95 PreK-K Families attended
  - o PS 18
    - 43 bags given out donated by MetroPlus
    - IBR (Institute for Basic Research) donated 100 24ct crayons
    - 4 volunteers from Hope Worldwide (Faith based organization)
  - o PS 74
    - 30 PreK/K families attended
  - Partner Feedback:
    - 3k families were also looking for support
    - Better organization on the part of the schools for the families know where to go and get supplies/resources
    - Good amount of information given to families
    - Try and find funding to support PreK families in a similar fashion to the We Got Your Back events
    - Better communication in multiple languages
    - Clearer flyers for families know what supplies are for what grade
  - Coming Next: Educator's Activate
    - Aiming to host in November
- Parent Surveys
  - 10 parents completed the survey
    - 7 English speaking parents
    - 3 Spanish speaking parents
  - Feedback:
    - Ask families if they have had their child <u>evaluated</u> (could have been found ineligible)
